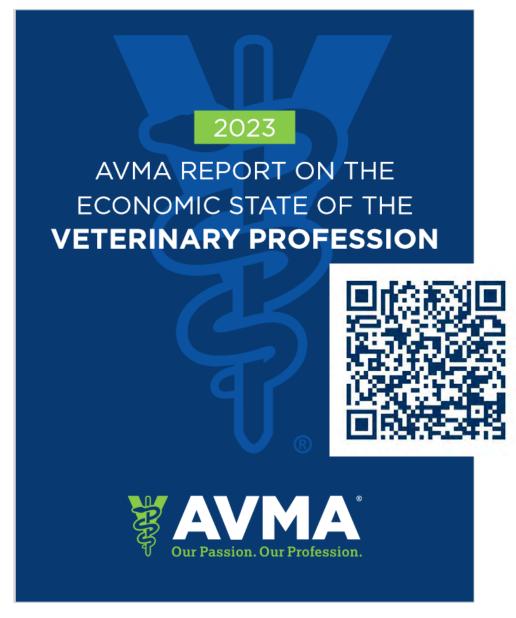

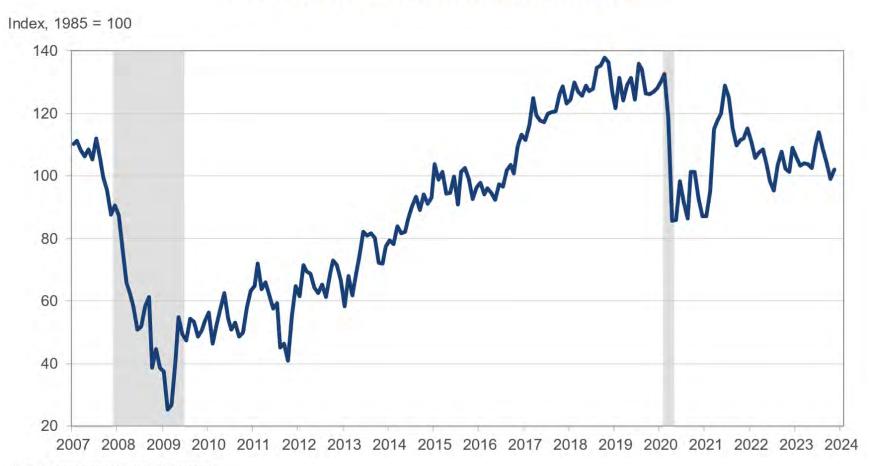
## **US Leading Economic Indicators Slowly Increasing**

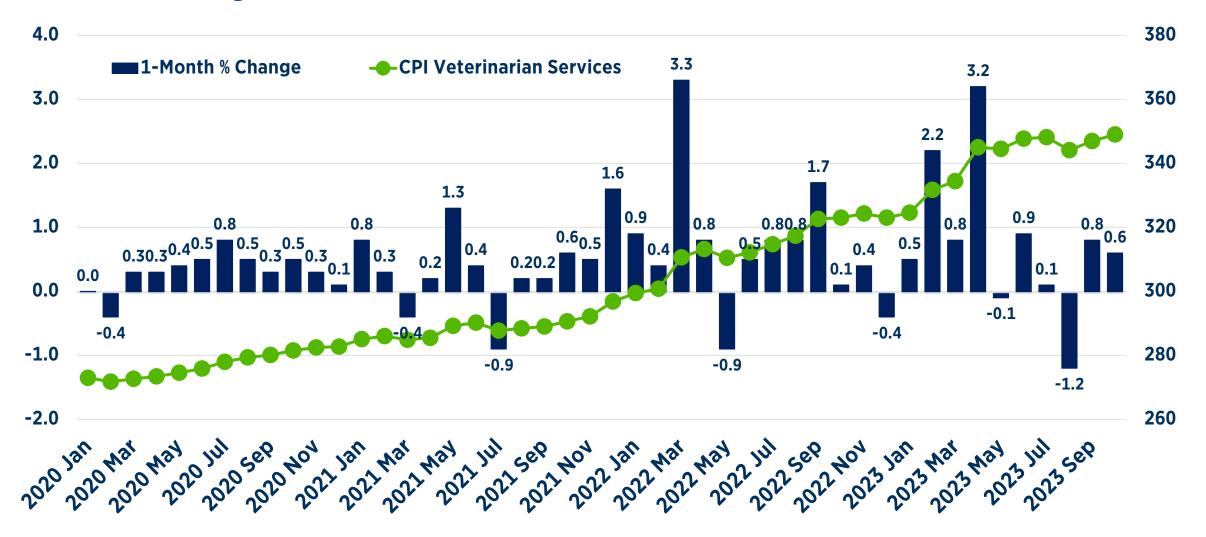

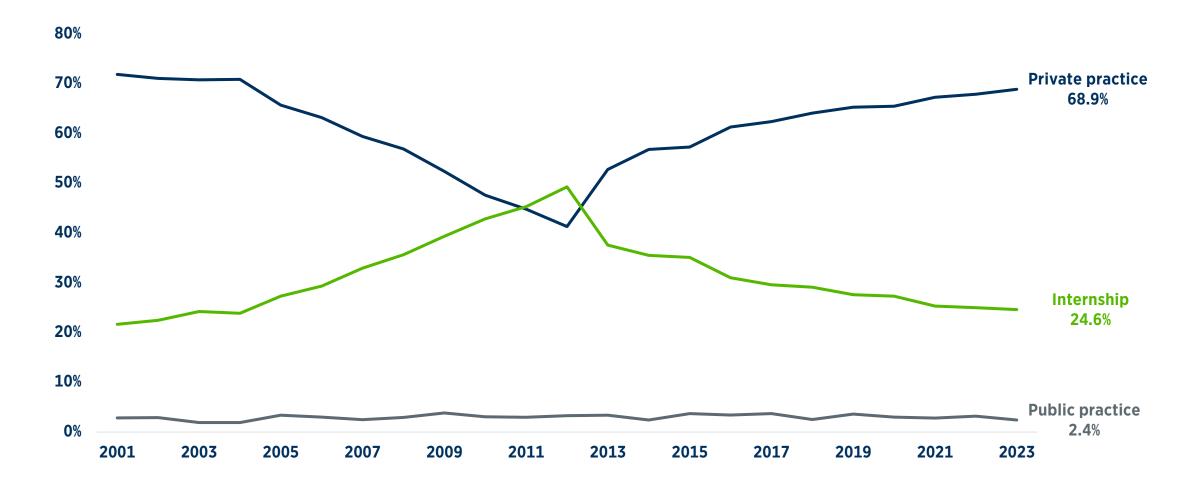

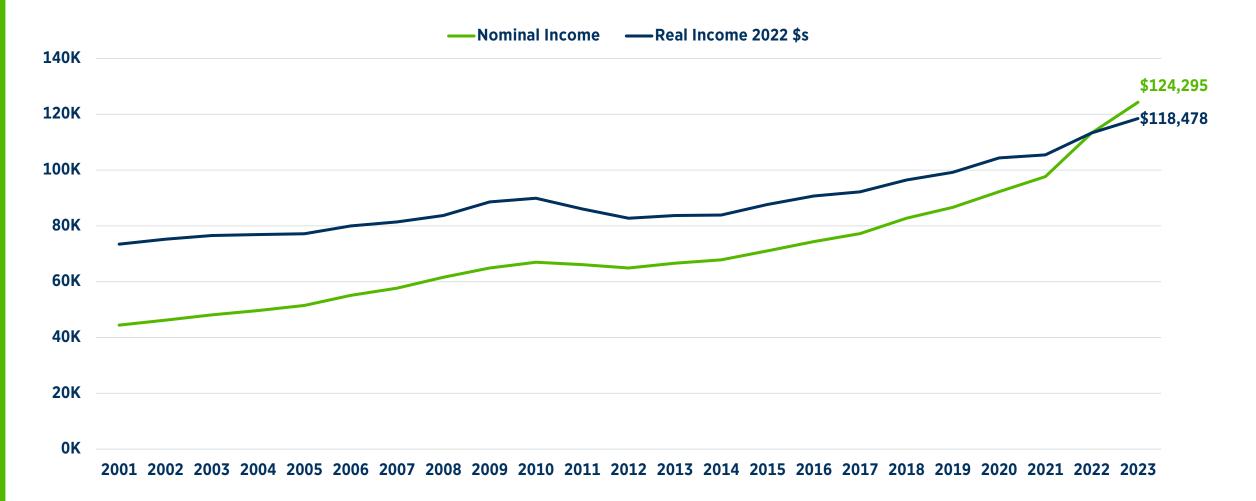

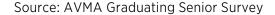






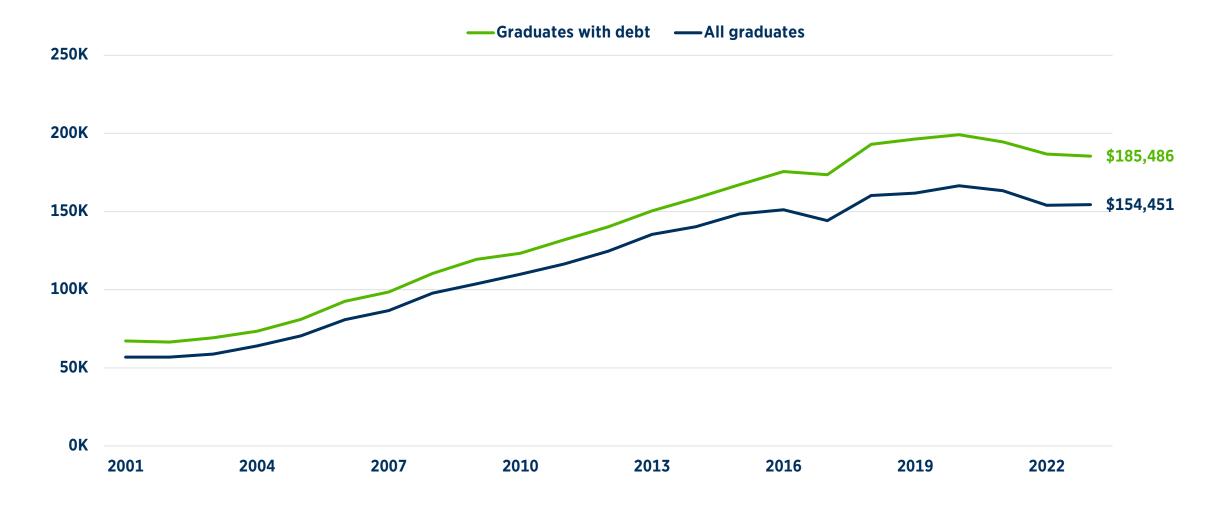
# Real Compensation On Pre-2008 Trajectory

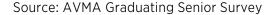






# **Average Debt Amounts Holding Steady**

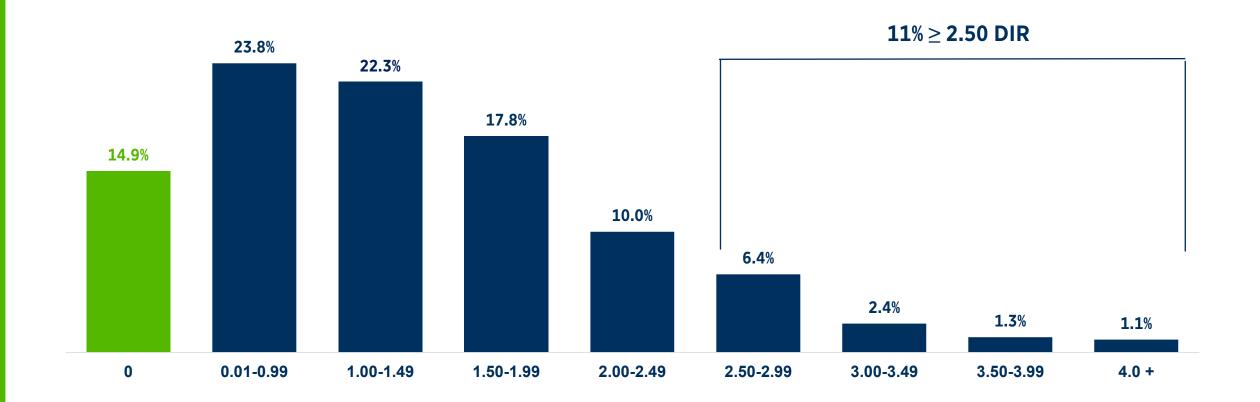






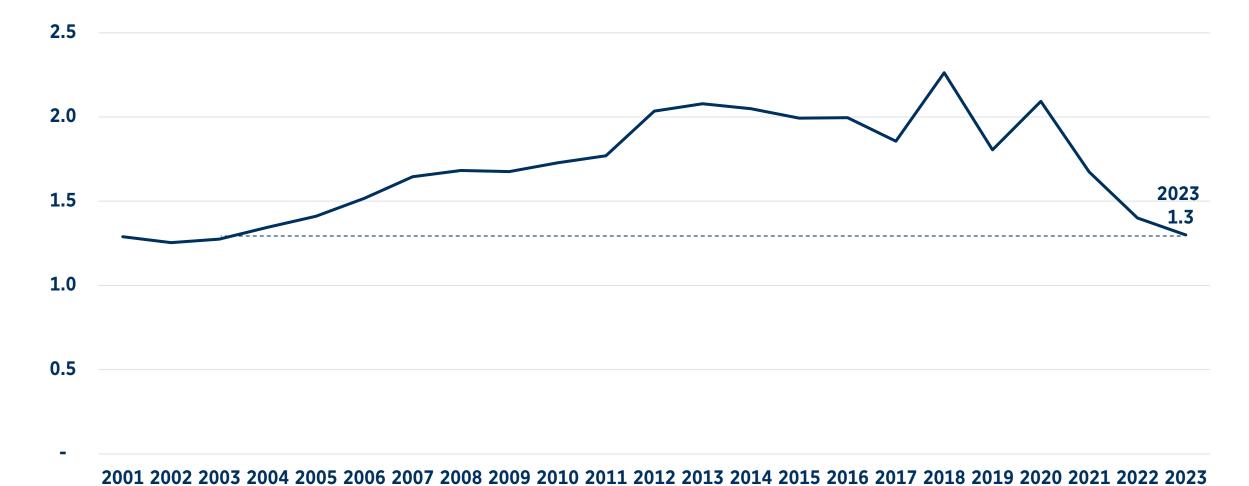
# **Rising Compensation and Steady Debt**

For those entering full-time employment, includes those with zero debt



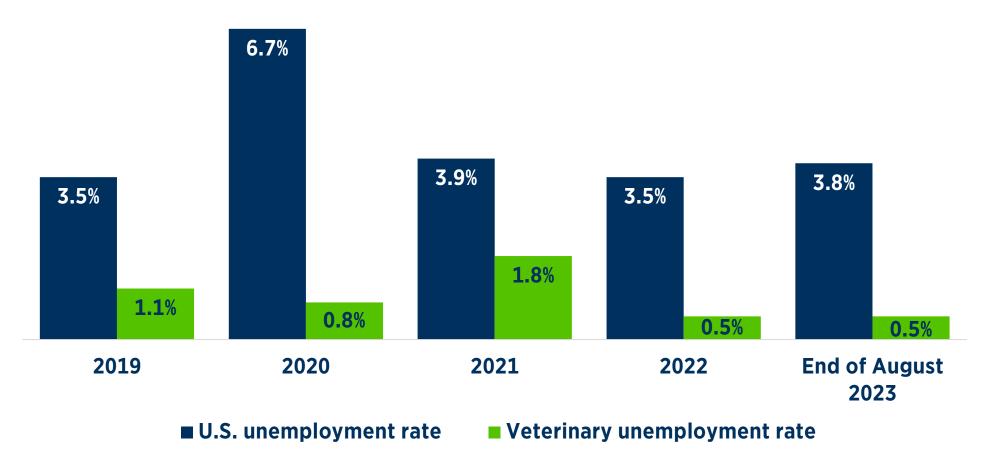

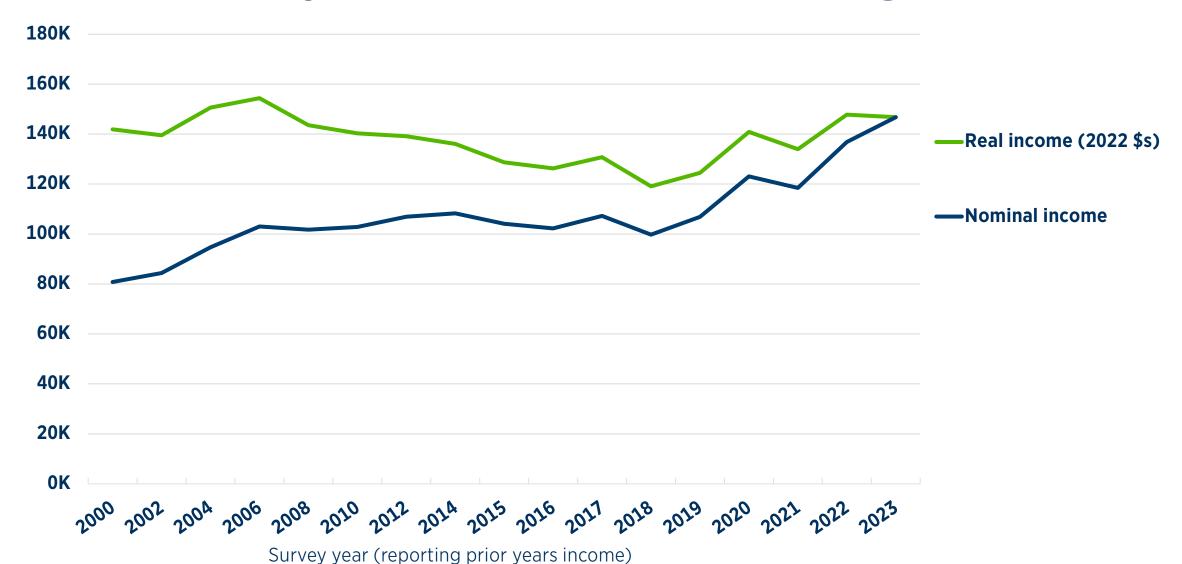

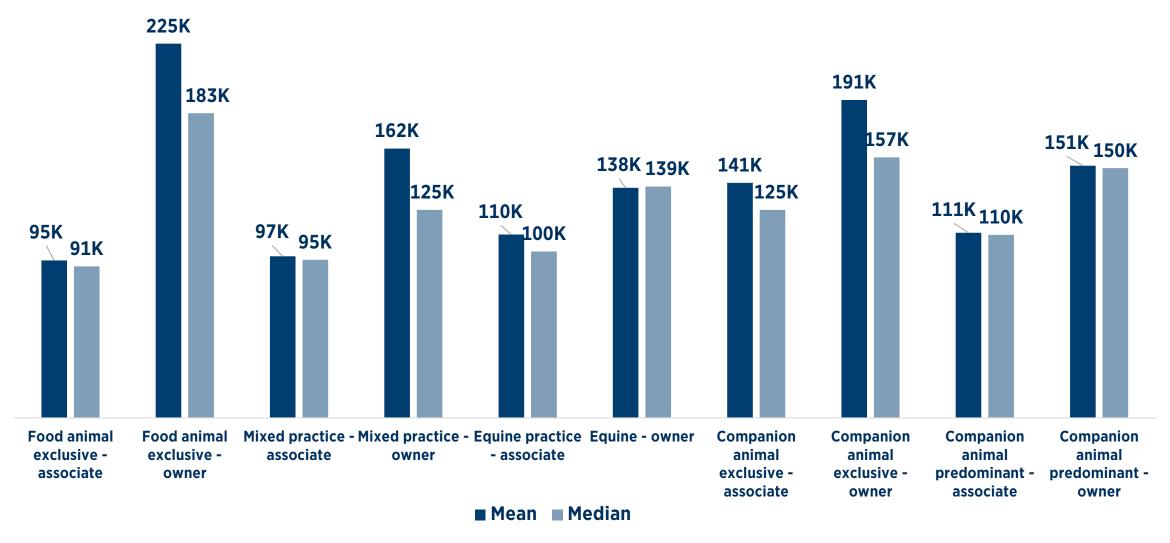
# Inflation Adjusted Incomes are Stagnant

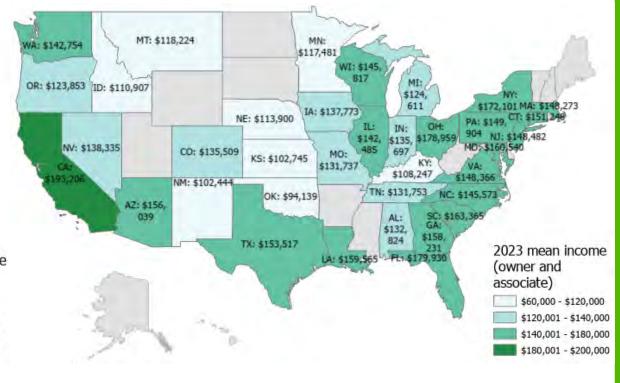

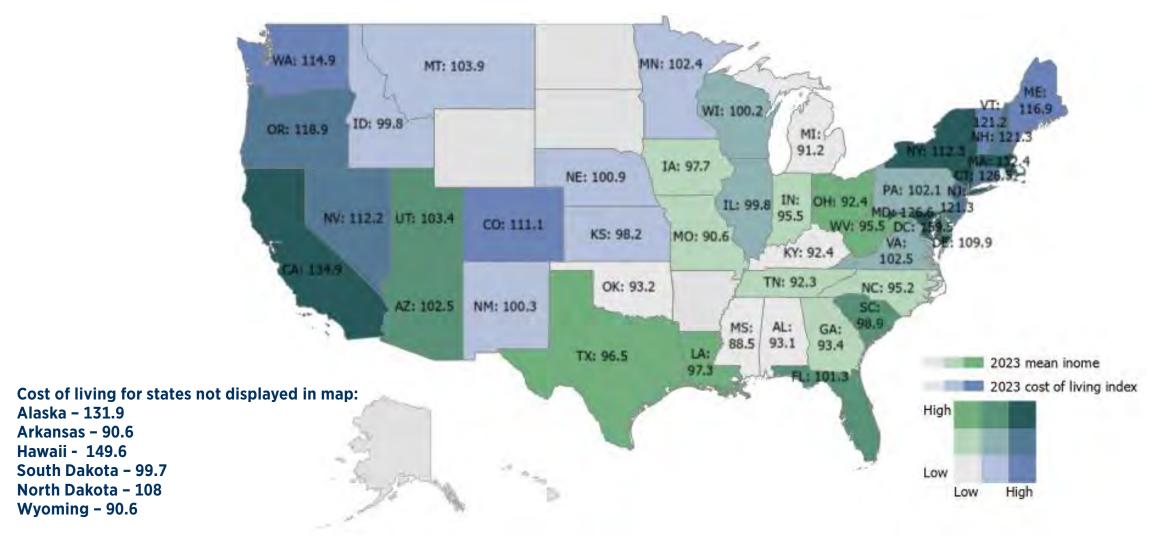

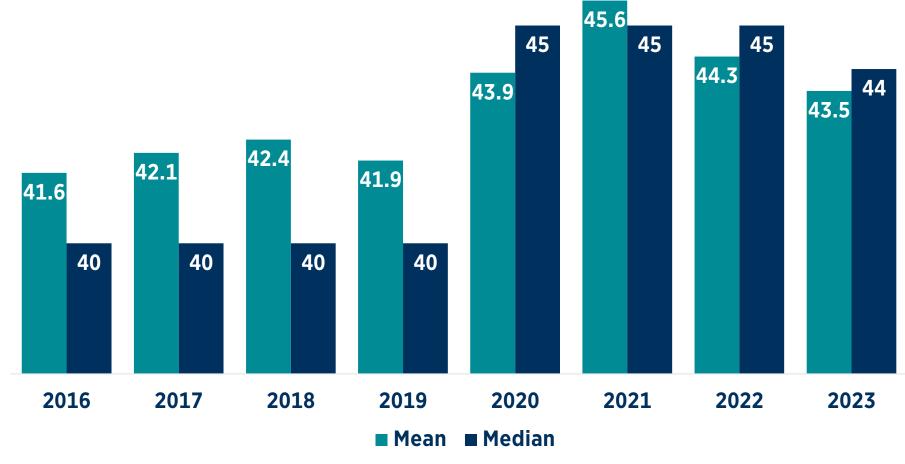

# Work Hours Declining, Remain Elevated Compared to Pre-Pandemic Levels



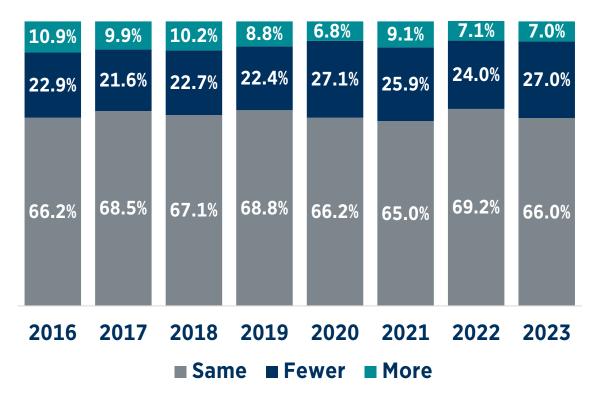
Number of hours worked per week (full- and part-time combined)

#### Pet Ownership and Demographic Survey: Leveraging the Data

#### **Pet Ownership Trends**



- -Tracks pet populations (primarily cats & dogs).
- -Identifies who pet owners are and what they value.

#### **Veterinary Visit Insights**



- -Cost of last visit.
- -Detailed wait times by appointment type.
- -Services utilized.
- -Client satisfaction and reasons why veterinarian not seen.

#### **Acquisition Information**

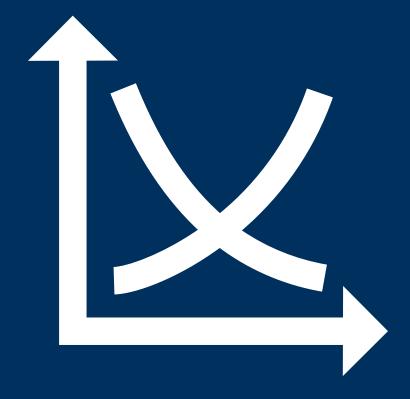


- -Provides attributes of people most likely to acquire pets in immediate future.
- -Determines where people are acquiring pets from.



#### **Five Factors of Demand**

- Income
- Price of goods & services
- Tastes and preferences
- Consumer expectations
- Number of consumers

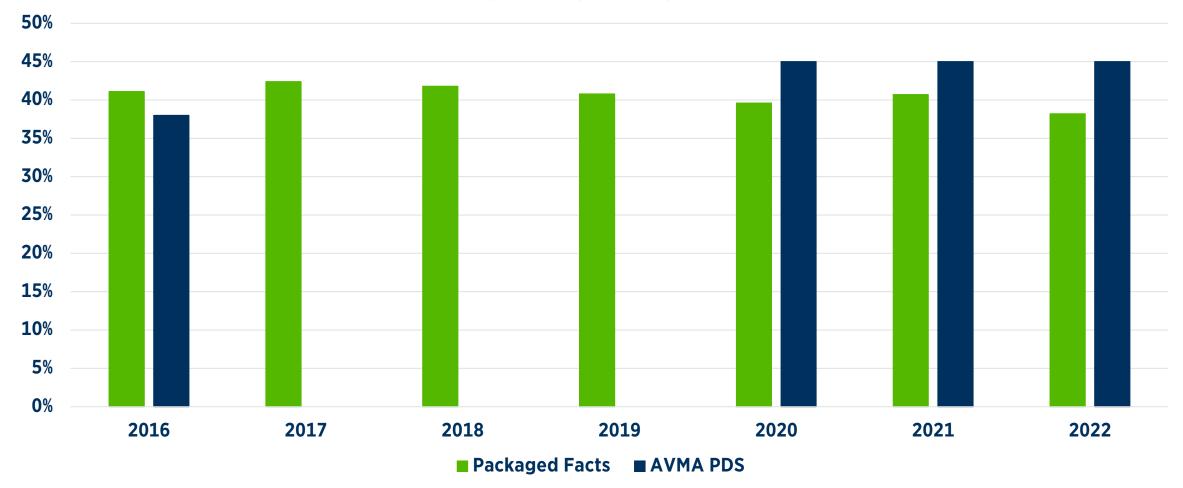

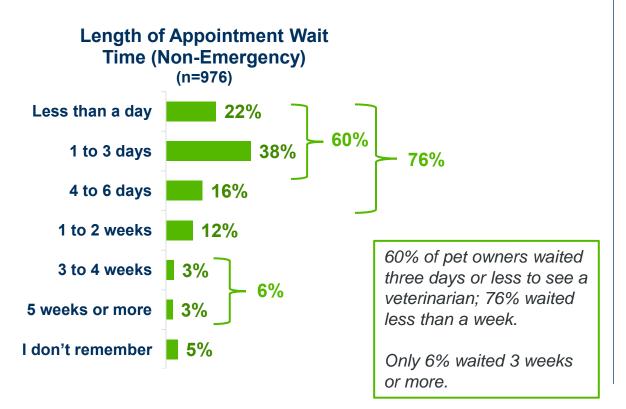




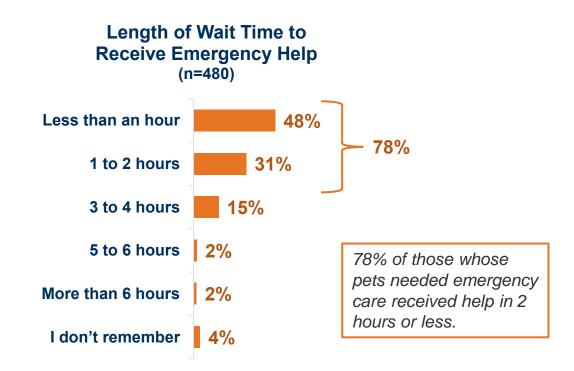

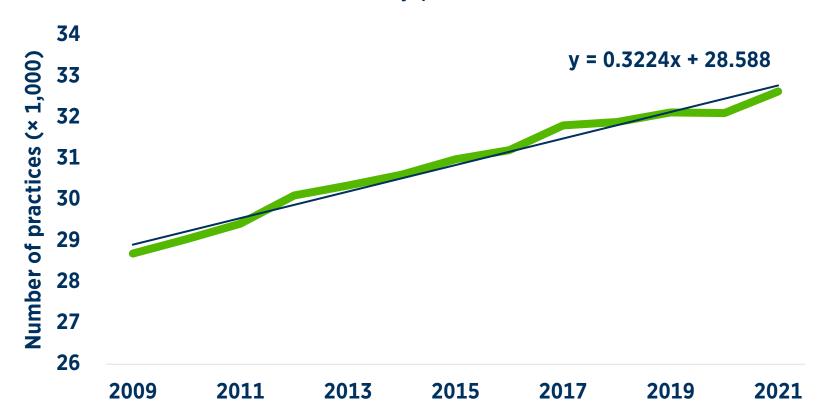

Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR)= **1.0**%

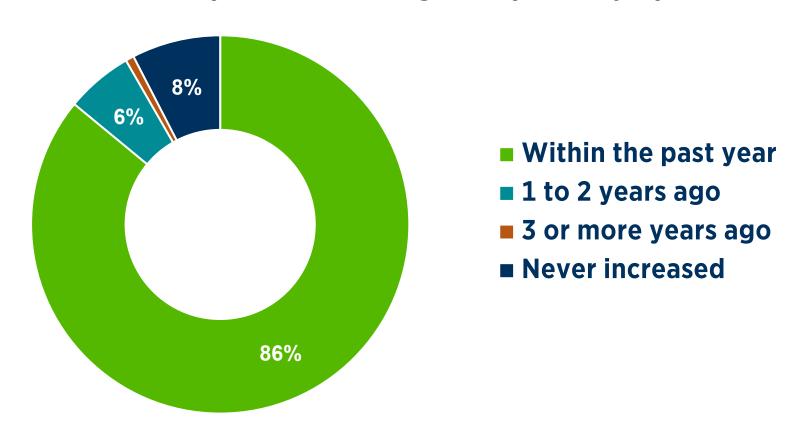

#### Most Veterinary Practices Raised Wages Within the Last Year

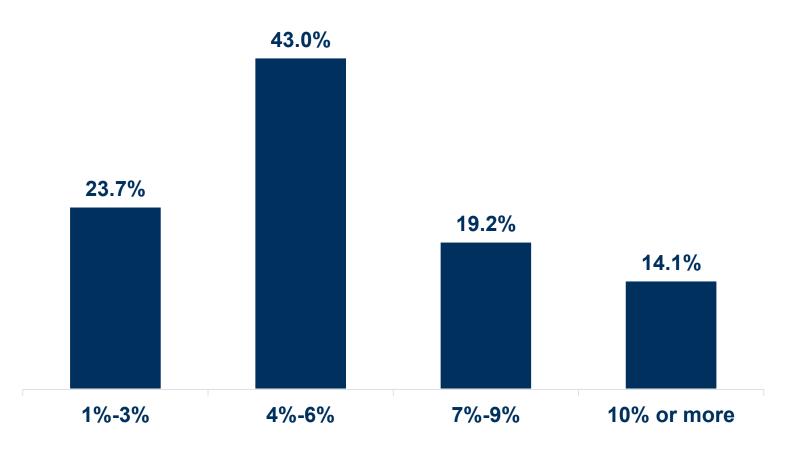
#### When did you last raise wages for your employees?

Labor (hours worked)

Capital (fixed costs, number of exam rooms)

**Gross revenue** 

Number of patients seen per year

Number of appointment slots per full-time equivalent (FTE) veterinarian per year

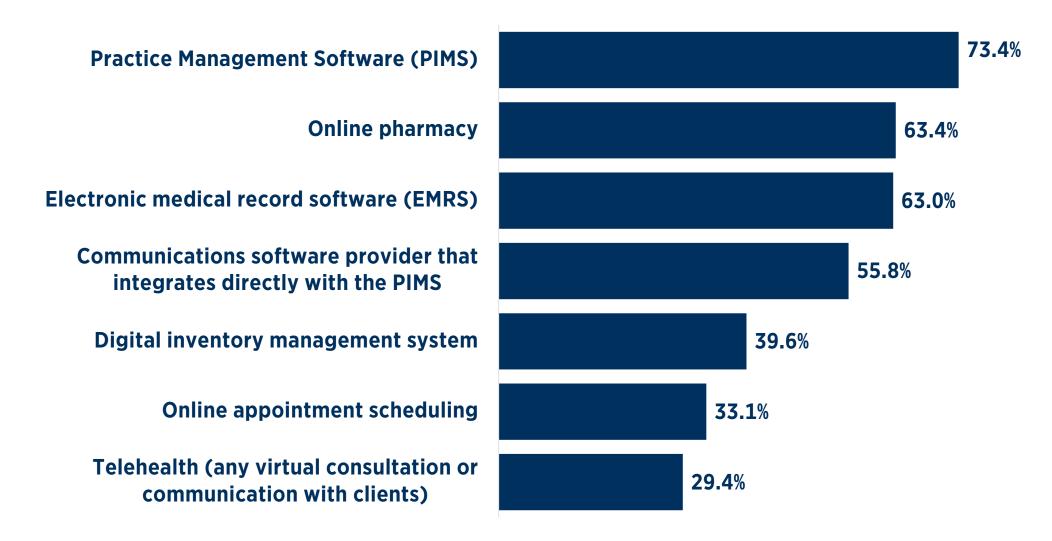

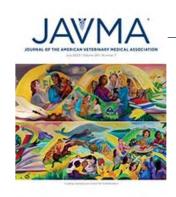
